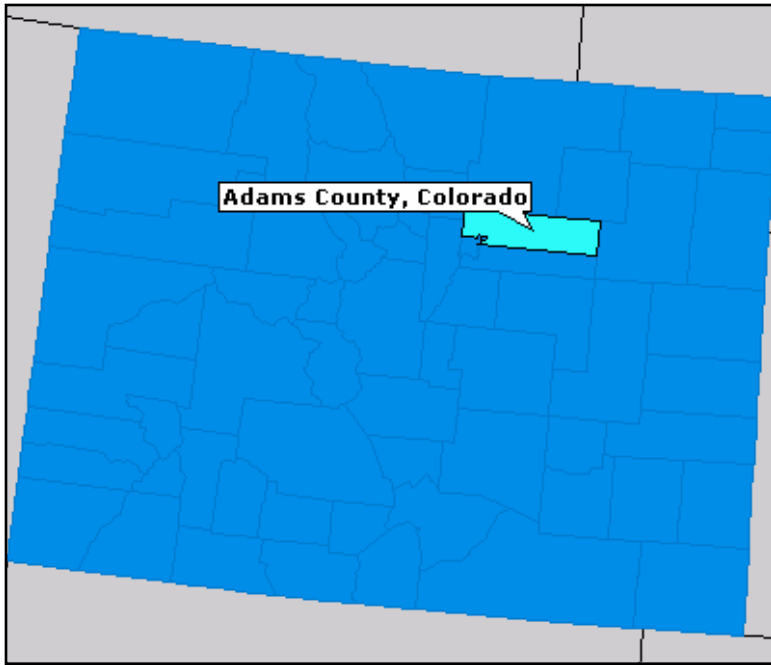

About Adams County

Adams County is the fifth most populous of the 64 counties of the State of Colorado. The U.S. Census Bureau estimates that the county population was 430,826 in 2008, a 23.87% increase since U.S. Census 2000.

It is named for Alva Adams, Governor of the State of Colorado 1887-1889, 1897-1899, and 1905. The county seat is Brighton. Adams County is part of the Denver-Aurora Metropolitan Statistical Area and the Denver-Aurora-Boulder Combined Statistical Area.
